

Cedarville Landowner Assessment of Stewardship and Satisfaction (CLASS)

Objective: To establish a dialogue with CU landowners and identify those who would be willing to cooperate in an effort to implement land stewardship, and stewardship of their time, energy, and finances. [This is intended for Computer Services only.]
